# **Mustard Seeds**

"For my eyes have seen your salvation. You have prepared it in the presence of all peoples-a light for revelation to the Gentiles and glory to your people Israel." Luke 2:30-32

It's the most wonderful time of the year! The ways we celebrate this time of year are many and varied, but for the disciples of Jesus our hearts thrill for what is at the center of it all, the earthly beginning of the fulfillment God's promises of the good news of Jesus. Messiah has come!

In the most recent *Mustard Seeds*, we marveled at the good news that is for all generations and how important it is to pass it along from one to the next. In this, we will look at God's wonderful, eternal plan for the gospel to be for all peoples of this earth.

The reality is that there is not a lot written about Jesus' birth and first few years of His life on earth. The Bible tells us of pre-birth happenings, the events surrounding the birth itself, and just a glimpse of the first few years of His earthly existence. But within that time, we see what would become the pattern of Jesus' earthly life in reaching out to Gentiles as well as Jews, and the blueprint of the assignment for the early church, and throughout the history of the church until we are with Him in glory, i.e., the proclaiming of the great good news of redemption through Christ to all peoples of the earth who believe and follow Him.

To be sure there were some connected to the early events of Jesus' life who were "locals". Zechariah, Elizabeth, and John the Baptist were from Judah. The shepherds were from the region. Simeon and Anna who were present at the circumcision and presentation of Jesus when He was but eight days old, humbly ministered in Jerusalem. But there were others who, whether knowingly or unsuspecting, played a significant role in what took place in those early years of our Lord. Mary and Joseph, though Jewish by faith, were from the far northern city of Nazareth, with the totality of Samaria separating them from Bethlehem, Jerusalem, and the territory of Judah. Caesar Augustus was the supreme ruler of the Roman empire. Herod had his roots tied to the same powers of the Roman empire. The worshipping magi came from the east, i.e., a foreign country. And although we have no biblical account of what took place in Egypt, Scripture defines a certain period of time in which Jesus and His earthly parents lived there.

The birth and first few years of Jesus' life served as a microcosm of God's purposes in Christ. God's deliverance in Christ extended to both His Old Testament people and to all peoples of the world. I'm sure glad it did, because otherwise I would not have had opportunity to know Him (and by the way, neither would you). We have many opportunities to share this great news with the nations. Ministering through *International Connection Point*, English as Second Language classes, mission projects of your local church and Phelps County Baptist Association, and witnessing personally with people you know whose roots are in a far-off place, to name just a few. It is not an option for us who are His disciples, they are our marching orders from our King. Anytime is a good time to begin. The Christmas season seems to be ideal now, doesn't it? Let's do it!
